The Wild Robot Content Questions

Question 1: (Pages 1-23)

How is Roz like a baby animal? (Page 8-10ish)

She “hatched from the box” and her surroundings are all new to her. She is exploring around her and she is curious.

What did Roz learn from the crab? (Page 13 and 14)

What did I, Roz the robot, learn from the crab?

How to climb the sea cliffs by using a wide stance and grippy hands.

How do you think Roz is feeling when she realizes she is on an island (if robots had feelings) and why? alone, scared, curious, nervous, etc.

Question 2: (Pages 24-44)

Why do you think Roz didn't mind the pine cones anymore? (Page 29)

Who was in the cave that Roz stomped into? (Page 32)

A brother and sister bear.

How did Roz get away from the bears that were attacking her? (Page 35)

How did Roz get away from us, the bears?

She jumped into a tree and started throwing pinecones at them.

What did Roz learn from the stick insect? (Page 41 and 42)

February 2: Question 8: (Pages 145-170)

How did Roz get a new foot and what was it made of? (Page 150-154)
